### UPDATED ADVICE: ILLAWEENA STREET CLOSURE

**6 September 2017**

As part of the Logan Enhancement Project, the section of **Illaweena Street** between Gowan Road and the Stretton Recreational Reserve car park **will be fully closed** to enable construction of the new Gateway Motorway bridges and fauna arch crossing. This closure will be implemented **from 8pm on the 15 September 2017 until 2019**.

It is the preference of Brisbane City Council (road authority for Illaweena Street) that a full closure be in place to allow for construction of the new Gateway Motorway bridges and fauna arch crossing to be undertaken as part of Transurban Queensland's Logan Enhancement Project.

During the closure, motorists are advised to use an alternative route. This is updated information further to the advice provided on 3 August 2017.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you in advance for your patience during these works.



## Construction methodology

Construction of the bridges over Illaweena Street is a complex undertaking involving working around live traffic on the Gateway Motorway and local traffic on Illaweena Street. Illaweena Street is also a major corridor for utility services, with all providers funnelling their services beneath the existing bridges. The very restricted work area beneath the existing bridges creates the need to close Illaweena Street to undertake the following construction activities safely:

- construction of new northbound and southbound bridges (two separate bridge structures with three lanes in each direction). Construction of these bridges includes piling, concrete pumping, lifting of bridge beams
- demolition of the two existing bridge structures
- relocation of services
- lowering of the existing road on Illaweena Street and reconstructing Illaweena Street to a new final level
- construction of a two span concrete arch bridge for fauna passage
- construction of a shared pathway.

We appreciate your patience during these important works and will continue to update you as work progresses.

## About the project

Transurban Queensland's \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project includes upgrading parts of the Logan and Gateway Extension motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing ramps at Compton Road. The project will improve safety and reliability, reduce travel times, enhance connectivity to key residential and business areas, and future proof the network.

In December 2016, CPB Contractors, a member of the CIMIC Group, was awarded the contract for the detailed design and construction of the project. Major construction is underway with the project anticipated to be completed in 2019.
