

WORKS NOTIFICATION

August 2018

We're getting on with the job of upgrading your motorway network. As part of the project, from mid August 2018 construction activities will commence to upgrade the Logan Motorway at Paradise Road, Staplyton Road and Woogaroo Street, to provide a dedicated route for oversized vehicles.

This route will connect the Gateway Motorway and the western section of the Logan Motorway, allowing over-dimensional vehicles to travel along the Gateway Motorway to the Centenary Highway and the Ipswich Motorway.

The bridge over the Logan Motorway at Woogaroo Street is too low for oversized vehicles. New on and off-ramps will be constructed from the Logan Motorway (westbound) at Woogaroo Street, to allow over-dimensional vehicles to travel through this area. These ramp will be controlled access only, and will not be available for motorists.

Four cross over points (see map below) will be constructed in the median of the motorway to allow oversized vehicles to travel around overpasses as part of the route. This will provide travel time certainty and a more direct route for oversized vehicles heading west. Paradise and Staplyton road exits will have minor upgrades (widening) to service oversized vehicles.

Construction activities within the project corridor in this area will involve:

- clearing vegetation (near Woogaroo Street), stripping of topsoil and earthworks
- installation of construction and road signage
- placement of temporary fencing and erosion and sediment controls
- construction of site entry points and access gates
- intermittent night works at various locations, including lane closures where required
- installation of drainage, and relocation of existing services.

What to expect during these works:

- increased activity around the work area including the presence of workers, vehicles and equipment
- road construction and resurfacing, road pavement profilers, compaction rollers, body trucks, line marking and use of hand tools, barrier relocation and installation of new signage
- traffic control and reduced speeds will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists and workers
- potential noise impacts from the use of machinery.

All works are scheduled to minimise impacts on the community and motorists. We thank you in advance for your patience during these works.

About the project

Transurban Queensland's \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project includes upgrading parts of the Logan and Gateway Extension motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Logan Motorway/Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing ramps on the Gateway Extension Motorway at Compton Road. Major construction is underway with the project anticipated to be completed in 2019.
