

WORKS NOTIFICATION

December 2017

As part of Transurban Queensland's \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project, a road traffic noise assessment has been undertaken across the project corridor.

At locations where the noise assessment shows that predicted noise levels from the completed project infrastructure will exceed Queensland Government road noise guidelines, noise mitigation including noise barriers are being built. It should be noted that while noise barriers are designed to reduce perceived loudness, they do not eliminate noise completely.

Logan Motorway, Berrinba noise barrier construction

Based on the outcomes of the project's noise assessment and detailed design process, a noise barrier will be built on the Logan Motorway near Anderson Street, Berrinba (refer to the map).

The noise barrier in this area will extend approximately 278m in length, and 1.5m-3.0m high depending on natural ground levels. It will consist of concrete panel walls, supported by steel vertical posts.

Construction of the noise barrier will commence in 2018, and is expected to take approximately two months, construction and weather permitting.

What to expect

Access to the Logan Motorway noise barrier construction area will be via Anderson Street, Berrinba. Construction activities will include:

- earthworks to prepare alignment, excavation of holes for footings
- erecting vertical posts, and installing pre-fabricated concrete panels
- painting / anti-graffiti treatment, facing the road alignment
- the use of excavators, trucks, mobile crane, light vehicles.

All works are scheduled to minimise impacts on the community and motorists. We thank you in advance for your patience during these works.

About the project

Transurban Queensland's \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project includes upgrading parts of the Logan and Gateway Extension motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Logan Motorway/Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing ramps at Compton Road. The project will improve safety and reliability, reduce travel times, enhance connectivity to key residential and business areas, and future proof the network.

In December 2016, CPB Contractors, a member of the CIMIC Group, was awarded the contract for the detailed design and construction of the project. Major construction is underway with the project anticipated to be completed in 2019.
