

SUSTAINABILITY STATEMENT

THE PROJECT

Transurban Queensland's \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project includes upgrading parts of the Logan and Gateway Extension motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing ramps at Compton Road. The project will improve safety and reliability, reduce travel times and enhance connectivity to key residential and business areas. Major construction is expected to start in mid-2017 with the project anticipated to be completed in 2019.

CPB Contractors, part of the CIMIC Group, are undertaking the design and construction of the motorway upgrade. Engineering design firms GHD, SMEC and Golder Associates are contracted to CPB Contractors to deliver the design for the project.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Participants in the Logan Enhancement Project are committed to:

- Improving the safety and efficiency of the motorway network
- Encouraging innovation and sustainability
- Minimising negative impacts on adjacent communities through design and mitigation
- Mitigating or managing environmental impacts associated with project
- Minimising disruption to traffic during construction
- Supporting local industry participation and providing employee training
- Undertaking the project in a manner which is cooperative and responsive to the needs of stakeholders and the local community
- Providing connectivity and continuity to active transport; and
- Developing, implementing and maintaining effective management systems for workplace health and safety, environment, sustainability and quality management.

Committing to these objectives and delivering the restorative actions included in the project will not only mitigate negative impacts, but also provide a positive legacy for road users and the community, now and in the future.
